Program Overview:

- Members of faith and community-based organizations trained as community health workers (CHWs)
- Interactive training on stroke and cardiovascular disease prevention led by health experts
- An eight-week training program, Tuesday–Thursday (6:00–9:00 PM)
- Trained CHWs conduct free community health screenings and referrals



REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be at least 18 years old
- Hold a high school diploma, GED, or equivalent work experience
- Fully vaccinated against COVID-19
- No significant visual, hearing, or memory impairments
- Commit to completing 8 weeks of training (6 weeks virtual, 2 weeks in-person)
- Ability to actively engage in classroom discussions and activities
- Successfully complete all training requirements
- Successfully participate in 3 screening events, post-graduation
